

NOTICE TO ALL MEMBERS OF MISSISSAUGA #8 FIRST NATION

A vote will be held on **November 28 to December 2, 2016** to ratify the Anishinabek Nation Education Agreement between **Mississauga #8 First Nation** and Canada. The Ballot question is:

Do you approve the Anishinabek Nation Education Agreement and acknowledge the First Nation Constitution?

You are eligible to vote if you are 18 years of age or older by the end of the Voting Period and your name appears on the band list or you are entitled to have your name appear on the band list. You will be required to produce identification in order to vote.

To confirm your name is on the Eligible Voters List or to receive instructions on the process to request changes to the Eligible Voters List, contact the First Nation Ratification Officer in person, by email, facsimile, or by phone number found at the end of this notice.
